Background

Saturday, February 20 is the final round of the golf tournament, shotgun start at 8:30 a.m. on Eagle Falls Golf Course and the Black Tie Gala with headliners, **The Smothers Brothers** and **Barbara Sinatra** will honor philanthropist **Wallis Annenberg** as the "Champion of the Children."

Tom Dreesen returns for the 22nd time as the master of ceremonies for all tournament parties; and he will be joined on-stage by chairwoman **Barbara Sinatra**, co-host **Robert Wagner**, honorary spokesman **Dick Van Dyke** and title sponsor **Bill Austin of Starkey Hearing Foundation**.

Sunday, February 21, Barbara Sinatra will host an **Open House and Tour of the Barbara Sinatra Children's Center** from 11:30 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. The public is invited at no charge.
